Pope John Paul II Catholic High School is an archdiocesan, co-educational senior high school serving the community of St. Tammany Parish and the surrounding area. Opened in 1980, the school provides a Catholic academic setting for 427 young men and women through a Standards Based Educational Curriculum infused with Christian values.

A school dedicated to the mission of **Academic Excellence, Faith Development and Leadership**, the young men and women of Pope John Paul II are challenged to excel, while growing in self-confidence, self-worth and thoughtful inquiry.

FACULTY

There are 32 professional staff members and 11 have master's degrees. The average teaching experience is 10.75 years and there is a ratio of one faculty member to each 13.9 students.

ACCREDITATION

Pope John Paul II Catholic High School is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools and is approved by the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education.

TESTING

As a college preparatory school, students take and prepare for a variety of standardized tests, most of which are administered on campus. PJP administers EXPLORE to entering freshmen. Grades 9, 10 and 11 take ITED. Sophomores take the PLAN test and juniors participate in the PSAT/NMSQT and ASVAB exam. The ACT is offered to students four times a year at Pope John Paul II. Through classroom instruction, students are also prepared for the SAT I and SAT II, which is taken off-campus.

TECHNOLOGY

Technology at PJP contributes to the overall quality of the curriculum and enhances the educational experience. Each student is equipped with an IBM tablet PC featuring note-taking software, organizational tools, study aids, and wireless access to on-line resources and textbooks. Classrooms are equipped with the latest in projection technology allowing faculty to fully integrate technology into daily lesson plans. The biology laboratory utilizes 10 IBM desktop computers, digital camera and projection equipment and accessories to facilitate learning and exploration through laboratory exercises and demonstrations.

GRADING SYSTEM AND RANK IN CLASS

The breakdown for grades is as follows for College Prep:
A=93-100, B=83-92, C=75-82, D=68-74, F=below 68
For Honors and AP:
A=93-100, B=85-92, C=77-84, D=70-76, F=below 70

The traditional quality point system is used in the regular college preparatory classes:
A=4.0, B=3.0, C=2.0, D=1.0, F=0
In Honors and AP classes, quality points are assigned as follows:
A=5.0, B=4.0, C=3.0, D=2.0, F=0

Grades achieved in all credit courses are counted for rank in class.
